


Last year I was given the opportunity to teach K-2 Special Education where I was able to work with a wide variety of students! This academic school year, I am working 7-8 English and Language Arts!







Q15 - What is the approximate percentage of students in your class(es) that are categorized as gifted or advanced?





Q16 - What is the approximate percentage of students in your class(es) that are categorized as Native American?









Students will accurately recall multiplication facts.


Since multiplication is such an important piece of the 3rd grade standards, I felt it was an essential goal for students to perform.

The pretest assesses knowledge of the pronouns and other categories. Students will be asked to identify pronouns within a sentence, to label them according to the category, as well as identify vague pronouns within a sentence, rewriting it correctly. Students will take the same pretest again at the end of the 1st quarter.

Pretest Data:

Low Group (0-5 correct) = 6 students Low-Middle Group (6-10 correct) = 24 students Middle Group (11-15 correct) = 20 students High Group (16-21 correct) = 21 students

Some students struggled to understand multiplication (those that were Special Education students). They were not exposed/practiced multiplication facts as much since they were focused on their more specific learning goals stated on their IEPs.

Success: Through the Quill online resource, students are given a number of assignments to help them gain proficiency in the following skills, along with many others.

6.L.1a Ensure that pronouns are in the proper case (subjective, objective, possessive)

6L.1b Use intensive pronouns (e.g., myself, ourselves)

6.L.1c Recognize and correct inappropriate shifts in pronoun number and person.

As students complete each activity successfully, they are allowed to fill in a bingo board with the names of each activity. As they continue working, they will eventually get a "bingo" for a reward. The goal is for all students to eventually fill their bingo cards completely to get a "blackout". This encourages students to continue practicing the given skills. During working time, I can monitor how students are progressing and can help them along the way. This allowed practicing skills to become somewhat fun for students.

Downfall: If students are constantly out of class and not able to participate in the activities that are supposed to improve their skills, this will make it very difficult for them to grow. While this is out of my control, I can offer flexibility when it comes to the time of taking the post test.



Post-test (71 students): Low Group (0-5 correct) = 0 students Low-Middle Group (6-10 correct) = 9 students Middle Group (11-15 correct) = 22 students High Group (16-21 correct) = 40 students

In the grand scheme of things, this was a successful method for success. Considering this is my first time using Quill as a resource, I imagine that I will do a much better job of instructing my students on how to use it in the coming years.



Because these few students did not get the full practice before being tested, I imagine that their results could have been better had I paid more attention to these students. I will be more aware that ALL students complete the practice before taking the post test next time.
