

Student-Athlete Graduation Rates

Federal regulations require institutions that award athletically related student aid to disclose graduation rates for student-athletes receiving athletically related financial aid. This report satisfies the Student-Athlete Graduation Rate disclosure requirements under 34 CFR § 668.48.

Methodology

Graduation rates are reported in accordance with the U.S. Department of Education's Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). Unless otherwise noted, the rates represent first-time, full-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduate students who completed a bachelor's degree within 150% of the normal program length (six years for a four-year bachelor's degree). Student-athlete rates include first-time, full-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduate students who received athletically related student aid.

Definitions

General Student Body

The "General Student Body" columns represent first-time, full-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduate students included in the applicable IPEDS Graduation Rates cohort for graduation rate tables and the official Fall 2025 census enrollment for enrollment tables.

Student-Athlete

For purposes of this report, a student-athlete is a student receiving athletically related student aid as defined under 34 CFR §668.48.

Graduation Rate

Graduation rates represent the percentage of students completing a bachelor's degree within 150 percent of the normal program length (six years).

Four-Year Average Graduation Rate

The four-year average graduation rate summarizes outcomes across the Fall 2016 through Fall 2019 entering cohorts.

Race/Ethnicity

Race and ethnicity categories follow the federal IPEDS race/ethnicity reporting standards.

Sport Categories

Student-athletes are reported using the sport categories specified in 34 CFR §668.48.

Data Suppression

Cells within the subcohorts containing five (5) or fewer students are suppressed to protect student privacy.
