Cost / Payment Method

CLEP exams cost \$100 (\$85 to CLEP and \$15 to DSU)

CLEP requires you to pay and print a registration ticket from their website prior to testing.

1. Open the CLEP website: <http://clep.collegeboard.org/>.
2. Click **My Account** from the top-right corner.
3. Click the **Create an Account** button.
4. Complete the form and click **Next**.
5. Once you've created the account and paid for the exam, print the registration ticket.

Please bring the \$15 administration fee, the registration ticket, and one form of government issued ID to your CLEP exam appointment.

Scores

Your results will be available immediately after testing with the exception of the College Composition (with essay) exam. Please allow 3-4 weeks for the scoring of this exam.
