Cost / Payment Method

CLEP exams cost \$109 (\$89 to CLEP and \$20 to DSU)

CLEP requires you to pay and print a registration ticket from their website prior to testing.

1. Open the CLEP website: <http://clep.collegeboard.org/>.
2. Click **My Account** from the top-right corner.
3. Click the **Create an Account** button.
4. Complete the form and click **Next**.
5. Once you've created the account and paid for the exam, print the registration ticket.

Testing Day

Please bring the \$20 administration charge, the registration ticket, and one form of government issued ID to your CLEP exam appointment. Each CLEP exam takes approximately 90-minutes to complete; the College Composition exam takes approximately 120 minutes.

Scores

Your results will be available immediately after testing with the exception of the College Composition (with essay) exam. Please allow 3-4 weeks for the scoring of this exam.
