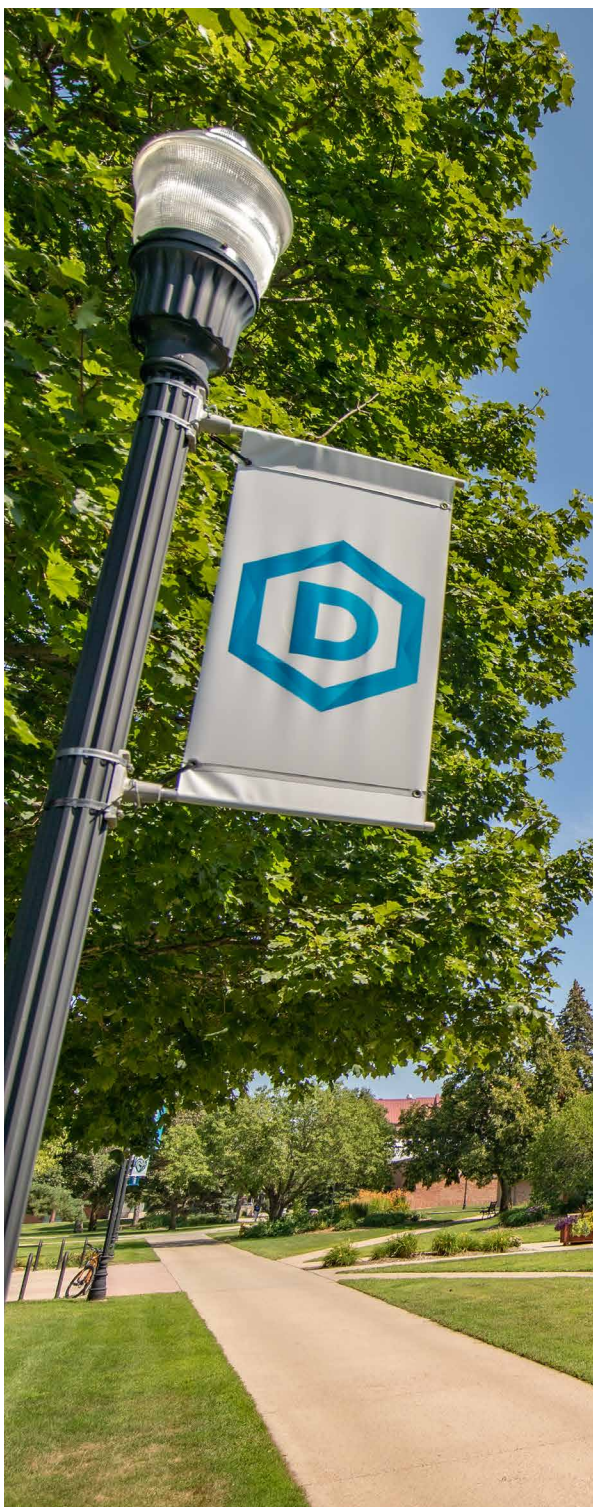

PAYMENT/REFUND

CAMPUS SAFETY

Campus Security is available through a partnership with the Madison Police Department. Our Safety Resource Officer is available Monday through Friday during normal business hours to assist with criminal reporting and law enforcement-related questions. The office is in the Trojan Center. Campus Watch is a student security team supervised by the university's Safety Resource Officer. They patrol campus in the evenings and are happy to help if you need it, whether it's walking you back to the halls from the library or jumpstarting your car. Watch specialists are on duty Tuesday through Sunday from 8:00 p.m. to midnight. To reach a Campus Watch employee for assistance, call 605-270-7712 or 605-270-7713.

Security cameras are installed across campus, and residence halls are controlled by card access so that only students who live in that building can enter.

To report an emergency on campus, dial 911.

TROJAN CARD & TROJAN SILVER

The Card Services Office is located at the ITS Help Desk in the Karl Mundt Library and issues the Trojan mobile ID, which is official identification for students, faculty, and staff at Dakota State University. After you have submitted your ID photo, you can add your Trojan ID to your device. Setup instructions can be found at dsu.edu/card-services/trojan-cardmobile-id.html.

Your Trojan ID can be used for anything. It is used at the library to check out equipment and materials. Use it for your meal plan, other on campus retail locations, and concessions. Use it to get into events and for appointments at Madison Regional Health. You can use it at DSU's Print Shop and Mail Services offices for printing and postal services. Additionally, the Trojan ID will give you access to your residence hall, vending around campus, academic buildings after hours, and the Community Center. And get your spirit gear and more from the Trojan Zone. You can even use it at select off-campus establishments. You will also need Trojan Silver to do laundry in the residence halls with the Speed Queen app.

You can manage your card online at sdeast-sp.transactcampus.com/DSU/AnonymousHome.aspx or using the Transact eAccounts app on your phone. You can add Trojan Silver funds, see balances, add mobile credential, or deactivate your account.

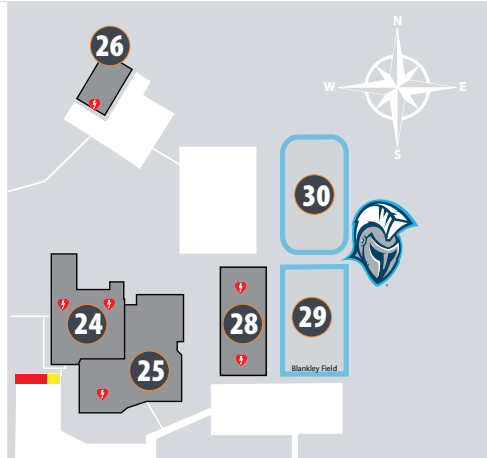
